LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 12, as introduced, Simitian. County water districts: residential water services.

The County Water District Law prohibits a county water district that furnishes water for residential use to a tenant from seeking to recover charges or penalties for the furnishing of water to or for the tenant's residential use from any subsequent tenant because of nonpayment of charges by a previous tenant, but permits the county water district to require that service to subsequent tenants be furnished on the landlord's or property owner's account.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive, technical change in that provision.
