LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 320, Reyes. Portable classrooms.

Existing law authorizes the State Allocation Board to lease portable classrooms to school districts and county superintendents of schools.

This bill would require the Office of the State Architect to conduct a study to evaluate the safety of the various means currently available for providing emergency exit from portable classrooms and to report the results of the study along with recommendations to the Legislature by July 1, 2003.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. (a) The Office of the State Architect shall conduct a study to evaluate the safety of the various means currently available for providing emergency exit from portable classrooms and report the results of the study along with recommendations to the Legislature by July 1, 2003.

(b) For the purposes of this section, "portable classroom" shall have the same meaning as set forth in subdivision (b) of Section 17042.5 of the Education Code.
