An act relating to health and welfare, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 429, as introduced, Committee on Budget. Health and welfare programs.

Existing law establishes various health and welfare programs.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to make the necessary statutory changes to implement the Budget Act of 2001 relative to the funding of health and welfare programs.

The bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this
2 act to make the necessary statutory changes to implement the
3 Budget Act of 2001 relative to the funding of health and welfare
4 programs.

5 SEC. 2. This act is an urgency statute necessary for the
6 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety

1 within the meaning of Article IV of the Constitution and shall go
2 into immediate effect. The facts constituting the necessity are:
3 In order to make the necessary statutory changes to implement
4 the Budget Act of 2001 at the earliest possible time, it is necessary
5 that this act take effect immediately.
