An act relating to land use.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 680, as introduced, Steinberg. Land use.

Existing law authorizes state and local governments to regulate land use through the adoption of state laws and local ordinances and regulations that include, but are not limited to, planning, zoning, subdivisions, and environmental quality.

This bill would declare the Legislature's intent to enact legislation to promote a regional approach to land use planning in the Sacramento region and to decrease local government's need to constantly generate more sales tax revenue.
