An act to add Section 298.6 to the Family Code, and to amend Section 6276.14 of the Government Code, relating to domestic partnerships. An act to add Section 10295.3 to the Public Contract Code, relating to public contracts.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1080, as amended, Kehoe. ~~Domestic partnerships: confidentiality~~ *State contracts: acquisition of goods or services.*

Existing law authorizes the Department of General Services to contract with suppliers to acquire goods and services for state agencies.

This bill would prohibit a state agency from entering into a contract for the acquisition of goods or services with a vendor or contractor who does not offer benefits to registered domestic partner employees equal to benefits offered to married employees.

~~Existing law requires that persons who seek to become domestic partners complete and file a Declaration of Domestic Partnership with the Secretary of State.~~

~~This bill would prohibit the Secretary of State from disclosing or providing public access to the mailing address of domestic partners and would make a related change to the Public Records Act.~~
