An act to ~~repeal Section 3085 of the Labor~~ amend Section 8152 of the Education Code, relating to apprenticeships.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1131, as amended, Frommer. Apprenticeship ~~agreements:~~ ~~remedies programs.~~

Existing law provides that reimbursement rate for apprenticeship education shall be established in the annual Budget Act. Existing law applies the reimbursement rate to isolated apprentices and defines isolated apprentices as apprentices registered with the Division of Apprenticeship Standards in the Department of Industrial Relations.

This bill would limit reimbursement under the existing provision for related and supplemental instruction provided to indentured apprentices to reimbursement for instruction provided by a program approved by the Division of Apprenticeship Standards.

~~Existing law prohibits a person from instituting court actions to enforce apprenticeship agreements unless the person has first exhausted all of his or her administrative remedies.~~

~~This bill would repeal that provision.~~

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 ~~SECTION 1. Section 3085 of the Labor Code is repealed.~~
- 2 SECTION 1. *Section 8152 of the Education Code is amended*

- 4 8152. (a) The reimbursement rate shall be established in the
- 5 annual Budget Act and the rate shall be commonly applied to all
- 6 providers of instruction specified in subdivision (d).
- 7 (b) For the purposes of this section, each hour of teaching time
- 8 may include up to 10 minutes of passing time and breaks.
- 9 (c) This section also applies to isolated apprentices, as defined
- 10 in Section 3074 of the Labor Code, for which alternative methods
- 11 of instruction are provided.
- 12 (d) The Superintendent of Public Instruction or the Chancellor
- 13 of the California Community Colleges, whichever is appropriate,
- 14 shall make the reimbursements specified in this section for
- 15 teaching time provided by high schools, unified school districts,
- 16 regional occupational centers or programs, community colleges,
- 17 or adult schools.
- 18 (e) *Reimbursements may be made under this section for related*
- 19 *and supplemental instruction provided to indentured apprentices*
- 20 *only if the instruction is provided by a program approved by the*
- 21 *Division of Apprenticeship Standards in the Department of*
- 22 *Industrial Relations in accordance with Chapter 4 (commencing*
- 23 *with Section 3070) of Division 3 of the Labor Code.*
