Introduced by Assembly Member Briggs

An act to amend Section 23393 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1216, as introduced, Briggs. Alcoholic beverages: licensees: beer and wine.

Under existing law, an off-sale beer and wine license authorizes the sale to consumers in quantities of 52 gallons or less per sale, for consumption off the premises where sold.

This bill would lower the maximum quantity authorized for sale by an off-sale beer and wine license from 52 gallons to 40 gallons per sale.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 23393 of the Business and Professions
2 Code is amended to read:
3 23393. A retail package off-sale beer and wine license
4 authorizes the sale, to consumers only and not for resale, of beer
5 in containers, and wine in packages and in quantities of ~~52~~ 40
6 gallons or less per sale, for consumption off the premises where
7 sold.
