An act relating to transportation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1303, as introduced, Hollingsworth. Transportation: Riverside County: alternative routes.

Existing law establishes the Traffic Congestion Relief Fund in the State Treasury and provides for the appropriation of money in that fund to the Department of Transportation for allocation to the department and certain regional and local transportation entities for the purposes of relieving traffic congestion, providing additional funding for local street and road maintenance, and providing additional transportation capacity in high growth areas of the state.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature that alternative routes that may be used to travel from Riverside County to Orange County be evaluated and considered.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.
