LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1956, as introduced, Vargas. Amusement machines.

Existing law regulates the operation of various types of businesses.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to regulate a business where amusement machines are offered for use by the public.
