An act to amend Section 6200 to the Penal Code, relating to conservation centers.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2673, as introduced, Cogdill. Conservation centers: Madera County.

Existing law establishes conservation centers under the jurisdiction of the Director of Corrections, for receiving, employment, care, custody, and education of inmates assigned thereto, as specified.

This bill would, in addition, establish the Madera Conservation Center, as specified.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6200 of the Penal Code is amended to  
2 read:  
3 6200. (a) There are hereby established, under the jurisdiction  
4 of the Director of Corrections, *the Madera Conservation Center*,  
5 the Sierra Conservation Center, the North Coast Conservation  
6 Center and the Southern Conservation Center, hereafter referred  
7 to collectively as the “conservation centers.”

- 1     *(b) The Madera Conservation Center shall use existing state*
- 2     *correctional facilities in the County of Madera, located in or about*
- 3     *Chowchilla.*
