LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2772, as introduced, Robert Pacheco. Employee assistance programs.

Existing law requires the Department of Personnel Administration to implement the State Employee Assistance Program to provide problem assessment and referral services to state employees. Existing law also creates within the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs, the Employee Assistance Consortium Demonstration Program to promote and facilitate the establishment of employee assistance programs designed to serve small businesses.

This bill would declare the Legislature's intent to define the scope of practice of persons who provide services in an employee assistance program.
