An act to add Article 25 (commencing with Section 2525) to Chapter 5 of Division 2 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to healing arts.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2789, as introduced, Lowenthal. Athletic Trainer Examining Committee.

Existing law, the Medical Practice Act, creates the Medical Board of California and makes it responsible for licensing and regulating the practice of a physician and surgeon.

This bill would create the Athletic Trainer Examining Committee within the Medical Board of California. The bill would make the board and the committee responsible for regulating those engaged in providing athletic training services.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
