An act to amend Section ~~2553~~ 3600 of the Family Code, relating to family law.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 3033, as amended, Committee on Judiciary. Family law.

Existing law authorizes a court to order temporary spousal support during the pendency of any proceeding for dissolution of marriage or legal separation, consistent with specified criteria.

This bill would delete all criteria except those relating to domestic violence, as specified.

~~Existing law authorizes a court to make any order the court considers necessary to carry out specified provisions of family law governing the division of property.~~

~~This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that provision.~~

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 ~~SECTION 1. Section 2553 of the Family Code is amended to~~

3 SECTION 1. Section 3600 of the Family Code is amended to

5 3600. During the pendency of any proceeding for dissolution
6 of marriage or for legal separation of the parties or under Division
7 8 (commencing with Section 3000) (custody of children) or in any
8 proceeding where there is at issue the support of a minor child or
9 a child for whom support is authorized under Section 3901 or
10 3910, the court may order (a) the husband or wife to pay any
11 amount that is necessary for the support of the wife or husband,
12 consistent with the requirements of ~~Sections~~ subdivisions (i) and
13 (m) of Section 4320 and Section 4325, or (b) either or both parents
14 to pay any amount necessary for the support of the child, as the case
15 may be.
