An act to add Part 8.5 (commencing with Section 15550) to Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to labor.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1236, as introduced, Alarcon. Labor Agency.

Existing law does not provide for the establishment of a Labor Agency in state government.

This bill would create in state government a Labor Agency. The agency would be under the supervision of a Secretary of the Labor Agency who would be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

8 15550. As used in this part, "agency" and "secretary" refer
9 to the Labor Agency and the Secretary of the Labor Agency,
10 respectively, unless the context otherwise requires.



1 15551. The Labor Agency in state government is under the
2 supervision of an executive officer known as the Secretary of the
3 Labor Agency. The secretary shall be appointed by the Governor,
4 subject to confirmation by the Senate, and shall hold office at the
5 pleasure of the Governor.
