An act to amend Section 2108.1 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to transportation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 338, as introduced, Levine. Local streets and highways: pavement management program.

Existing law requires the City, County, State Cooperation Committee in the Department of Transportation to develop and adopt by July 1, 1990, a pavement management program to be utilized on local streets or highways that receive funding under the state transportation improvement program.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2108.1 of the Streets and Highways  
2 Code is amended to read:  
3 2108.1. By July 1, 1990, the City, County, State Cooperation  
4 Committee in the ~~department~~ *department* shall develop and adopt  
5 a pavement management program to be utilized on local streets or  
6 highways that receive funding under the state transportation  
7 improvement program.

1 The pavement management program shall be transmitted to  
2 every county and city for possible adoption or incorporation into  
3 an existing pavement management program.  
4 The City, County, State Cooperation Committee shall solicit  
5 recommendations from transportation planning agencies and any  
6 other entity the committee deems appropriate.
