An act to add Section 68511.7 to the Government Code, relating to courts.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 759, as introduced, Nakanishi. Judicial Council: trial courts.

Existing law requires the Judicial Council to undertake studies and adopt rules relating to the administration of the trial courts.

This bill would require the Judicial Council to adopt rules providing for the public to attend any meeting of a board, committee, or multimember body of a trial court on matters related to administrative functions of the court.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 68511.7 is added to the Government
2 Code, to read:
3 68511.7. The Judicial Council shall adopt rules providing for
4 the public to attend any meeting of a board, committee, or
5 multimember body of a trial court on matters relating to the
6 administrative functions of the trial court. The rules shall provide
7 for the exclusion of members of the public on matters relating to

1 security issues. The provisions of this section do not apply to the
2 judicial functions of the trial court.
