An act relating to state property.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 955, as amended, Wiggins. Surplus state property: Sonoma Development Center: Jack London State Park.

Existing law provides for the declaration of surplus property by state agencies and the transfer of those properties to the jurisdiction of the Department of General Services. The department may transfer surplus property to other state agencies under certain circumstances.

This bill would require that, *with a specified exception*, if property under the jurisdiction of the Sonoma Developmental Center is declared surplus and transferred to the jurisdiction of the Department of General Services pursuant to these provisions, the department shall transfer that property to the Department of Parks and Recreation to be added to Jack London State Park. *It would authorize the Department of Parks and Recreation to transfer a portion or portions of the property to the County of Sonoma for the purpose of expanding the Sonoma Valley Regional Park.*

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Legislature finds and declares all of the
 2 following:

3 (a) The Sonoma ~~Development~~ *Developmental* Center, located
 4 on Arnold Drive in Sonoma County, *and adjacent to Jack London*
 5 *State Park and Sonoma Valley Regional Park*, is operated by the
 6 State Department of Developmental Services.

7 (b) The ~~130-building center~~ *center occupies 1,123 acres and*
 8 *contains a 130-building campus that is home to approximately*
 9 *900 individuals with developmental disabilities. The campus is*
 10 *located within the following boundaries of the center:*

11 (1) *Manzanita to Eucalyptus to the west.*
 12 (2) *Railroad to Trestle Glen Drive to the east.*
 13 (3) *Circle Drive to the southwest.*
 14 (4) *Parcel boundary to the southeast.*
 15 (5) *North Street to the northwest.*
 16 (6) *Railroad to the northeast.*

17 (c) The center has been an important community asset since the
 18 early 1900s, and the Legislature supports the continued operation
 19 of the center in its current configuration and location.

20 SEC. 2. ~~¶~~ *With the exception of land currently occupied by*
 21 *the Sonoma Developmental Center campus, as described in*
 22 *subdivision (b) of Section 1, if property under the jurisdiction of*
 23 *the Sonoma Developmental Center is declared surplus and*
 24 *transferred to the jurisdiction of the Department of General*
 25 *Services pursuant to Section 11011 of the Government Code, the*
 26 *Department of General Services shall transfer the property to the*
 27 *Department of Parks and Recreation to be added to Jack London*
 28 *State Park. In addition, the Department of Parks and Recreation*
 29 *may, at its discretion, transfer a portion or portions of the surplus*
 30 *property to the County of Sonoma for the purpose of expanding the*
 31 *Sonoma Valley Regional Park.*

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
