An act to amend Section 8702 of the Education Code, relating to instructional programs.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1330, as introduced, Simitian. Environmental education.

Existing law contains legislative findings and declarations regarding the need for an educational program that is designed to build attitudes of stewardship toward the maintenance of the quality of our environment and to enable all citizens to use resources wisely.

This bill would, in addition, declare that those attitudes are best developed at an early age through programs that encourage personal responsibility and participation in the local community.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
