An act to add Chapter 2.65 (commencing with Section 65089.11) to Division 1 of Title 7 of the Government Code, and to add Section 9250.5 to the Vehicle Code, relating to local government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1546, as amended, Simitian. San Mateo County: vehicle fee for congestion and stormwater management programs.

Existing law provides for the imposition by air districts and other local agencies of fees on the registration of motor vehicles in certain areas of the state that are in addition to *the* basic vehicle registration fee collected by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

This bill would authorize the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County to impose an annual fee of up to \$4 on motor vehicles registered within San Mateo County for a program for the management of traffic congestion and stormwater pollution within that county. The bill would require a program with performance measures and a budget before the fee may be imposed. The bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles to collect the fee and distribute the proceeds, after deduction of specified administrative costs, to the association. The fee would terminate on an unspecified date *January 1, 2009*.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 2.65 (commencing with Section 2 65089.11) is added to Division 1 of the Government Code, to read: 3 CHAPTER 2.65. MANAGEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONGESTION AND 4 5 STORMWATER POLLUTION IN SAN MATEO COUNTY 6 7 65089.11. (a) The City/County Association of Governments 8 of San Mateo County, which has been formed by the resolutions 9 of a majority of the city councils and the board of supervisors within San Mateo County, and which represents a majority of the 10 population in the incorporated area of San Mateo County, may 11 impose a fee of up to four dollars (\$4) on motor vehicles registered 12 within San Mateo County. The City/County Association of 13 Governments of San Mateo County may impose the fee only if the 14 15 board of the association adopts a resolution providing for both the fee and a corresponding program for the management of traffic 16 17 congestion and stormwater pollution within San Mateo County as set forth in Sections 65089.12 and 65089.13. 18 19 (b) A fee imposed pursuant to this section shall become 20 effective on the date specified in the resolution adopted by the 21 board pursuant to subdivision (a). (c) The fee shall terminate on _____ January 1, 2009, unless 22 23 reauthorized by the Legislature. 24 65089.12. (a) The fees distributed to the City/County 25 Association of Governments of San Mateo County pursuant to 26 Section 9250.16 of the Vehicle Code shall be used for purposes of congestion management and stormwater pollution prevention as 27 28 specified in its adopted congestion management program, pursuant to Section 65089, and its approved National Pollutant 29 Discharge Elimination System permit issued pursuant to the 30

31 federal Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. Sec. 1251 et seq.).

32 (b) Not more than 5 percent of the fees distributed to the

SEC. 2. Section 9250.5 is added to the Vehicle Code, to read: 6 7 9250.5. (a) The department shall, if requested by the 8 City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County, 9 collect the fee imposed pursuant to Section 65089.11 of the 10 Government Code upon the registration or renewal of registration 11 of any motor vehicle registered in the county, except those vehicles 12 that are expressly exempted under this code from the payment of 13 registration fees. 14 (b) After deducting all costs incurred pursuant to this section,

15 the department shall distribute the revenues to the City/County16 Association of Governments of San Mateo County.

(c) The department may annually expend for its administrative
costs not more than the following percentages of the fees collected
pursuant to subdivision (a):

20 (1) During the first year after the fee is imposed, 5 percent.

21 (2) During the second year after the fee is imposed, 3 percent.

22 (3) During any subsequent year, 1 percent.
