An act relating to peace officers.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1671, as introduced, Chu. Peace officers: hate incidence training.

Existing law establishes the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training, and, among other duties, requires the commission to provide various specified courses of training for peace officers.

This bill would express the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would require the commission to develop a standardized method of identifying and reporting hate incidences.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 legislation to require the Commission on Peace Officer Standards
- 3 and Training to develop a standardized method of identifying and
- 4 reporting hate incidences.
