An act to amend Section 2553 of the Family Code, relating to family law.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1704, as introduced, Committee on Judiciary. Family law.

Existing law specifies that the superior court may make any orders the court considers necessary to carry out the purposes of provisions of the Family Code governing the division of marital property.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change in that provision.
