LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 11, as introduced, Cedillo. Public safety.

Existing law provides for public safety.

This bill would set forth the intent of the Legislature that the State of California shall develop criteria and procedures to improve public safety, responsibility, and accountability for all Californians.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature, by enacting this
2 measure, to do both of the following:

3 (a) Ensure California's future public safety and prosperity by
4 improving highway and road conditions for all Californians.

5 (b) Ensure that Californians shall have a responsibility to meet
6 state highway safety requirements.

7 SEC. 2. It is the intent of the Legislature that the State of
8 California shall develop criteria and procedures to improve public
9 safety, responsibility, and accountability for all Californians.
