An act to amend Section 4456 of the Labor Code, relating to workers' compensation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 264, as introduced, Denham. Workers' compensation.

Existing law requires that disability payments due to an employee who is injured while engaged in an unemployment work relief program be determined on the monthly earnings or anticipated earnings of the employee from the program.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to those provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4456 of the Labor Code is amended to
 2 read:
 3 4456. Where any employee is injured while engaged on any
 4 unemployment work relief program conducted by the ~~State~~ state,
 5 or a political subdivision, or any ~~State~~ state or governmental
 6 agency, the disability payments due under this division shall be
 7 determined solely on the monthly earnings or anticipated earnings
 8 of ~~such~~ the person from ~~such~~ the program, ~~such payments to and~~
 9 shall be within the minimum and maximum limits set forth in
 10 ~~section~~ Section 4453.

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
