SENATE BILL

An act relating to water, and making an appropriation therefor.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1197, as amended, Denham. Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002: water storage facility.

The Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002, an initiative measure approved by the voters at the November 5, 2002, statewide general election, authorizes the issuance of bonds in the amount of \$3,440,000,000 for the purposes of financing a safe drinking water, water quality, and water reliability program. Of that amount, \$825,000,000 is available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for the balanced implementation of the CALFED Bay-Delta Program, including \$50,000,000 for surface water storage planning and feasibility studies.

This bill would appropriate ~~an unspecified amount of money~~ \$4,500,000 from bond funds made available by that surface water storage provision of the act to ~~an unspecified entity~~ *the Department of Water Resources* to finance the planning of a water storage facility on the upper San Joaquin River.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

8 storage facility on the upper San Joaquin River, consistent with
9 Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 79550) of Division 26.5 of
10 the Water Code.
