An act to add Section 5058.8 to the Penal Code, relating to corrections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1400, as introduced, Romero. Corrections: Office of Internal Affairs.

Under existing law, a member of the Office of Internal Affairs of the Department of Corrections is a peace officer, and training requirements are specified for those officers. Regulations make reference to the Office of Internal Affairs, and provide that certain sexual violations be reported to, and that uses of deadly force be pursued by employees designated by, officers of the Office of Internal Affairs, as specified.

This bill would require the department to establish written criteria for investigations conducted by the Office of Internal Affairs.
