An act relating to state audits.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1597, as introduced, Karnette. State audit: programs, mandates, and regulations.

Existing law sets forth the criteria for the audit of state agencies and their activities for various purposes.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation providing for the audit of all state agencies with respect to programs, mandates, and regulations imposed on those agencies since 1995, for specified purposes.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
2 legislation providing for the audit of all state agencies with respect
3 to programs, mandates, and regulations imposed on those agencies
4 since 1995, to ensure that those programs, mandates, and
5 regulations were implemented as directed, to assess their
6 effectiveness, and to determine whether they should be repealed.
