CHAPTER _____

An act to add Section 5030 to the Penal Code, relating to prisoners.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1676, Romero. Prisoners.

Existing law requires every public official in charge of a prison, jail, or other place of detention to keep a record of all disciplinary infractions and punishments administered therefor.

This bill would require the Department of Corrections and the Department of the Youth Authority to collect specified data regarding lockdowns and require the Department of Corrections and the Department of the Youth Authority to post the information to the respective department's Web site.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5030 is added to the Penal Code, to read:

5030. (a) The Department of Corrections and the Department of the Youth Authority shall collect data regarding lockdowns, as specified in subdivision (b). The information shall be posted by the Department of Corrections and the Department of the Youth Authority on the respective department's Web site and shall be updated quarterly. The information shall be collected and displayed on the Web site for each facility. Only lockdowns of 15 days or longer shall be reported pursuant to this section.

(b) The information collected shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- (1) The beginning date of the lockdown.
- (2) The duration of the lockdown.
- (3) The current lockdowns for the currently reported quarter, and the lockdowns that occurred in the prior quarter.
- (4) The name of the institution.
- (5) The name of the housing unit or other units or portions of units subject to the lockdown at the institution.
- (6) Identifying characteristics of the population subject to the lockdown, such as ethnicity, or race.
- (7) The inmate classification level subject to the lockdown.



- (8) The reason for imposing the lockdown.
- (9) The reason for lifting the lockdown.
- (10) The number of prisoners subject to the lockdown.
