An act to relating to plastics.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1749, as introduced, Karnette. Plastics.

Existing law generally requires every rigid plastic packaging container sold or offered for sale in the state to meet one of several criteria, which include, among other things, that the container have a certain recycling rate, as specified.

This bill would declare the Legislature's intent to examine the rigid plastics law in order to increase the recycling rate of plastics in the state.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Legislature intends to examine the rigid
2 plastics law in order to increase the recycling rate of plastics in the
3 state, over the rates required by Section 42310 of the Public
4 Resources Code.
