Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 108—Relative to Crynthia and Erling Hjertager Memorial Highway and the Erling Hjertager Memorial Bridge.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 108, as introduced, La Malfa. Crynthia and Erling Hjertager Memorial Highway and the Erling Hjertager Memorial Bridge.

This measure would designate the portion of State Highway Route 3 between Etna and Callahan in the County of Siskiyou as the Crynthia and Erling Hjertager Memorial Highway. The measure would rename the Wildcat Creek Bridge on State Highway Route 3 in the County of Siskiyou as the Erling Hjertager Memorial Bridge.

The measure would also request the Department of Transportation to determine the cost of appropriate signs and markers showing these special designations, and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs and markers.

1 WHEREAS, Crynthia and Erling Hjertager were two  
2 exceptionally generous individuals who continuously and  
3 unreservedly contributed to the community of Scott Valley over  
4 a period of fifty years; and

5 WHEREAS, Crynthia and Erling Hjertager donated their time  
6 and capital to the community of Scott Valley in times of dire  
7 need and emergency; and

1 WHEREAS, Erling Hjertager was known to personally fly  
2 individuals, at a moments notice and free of charge, to San  
3 Francisco that were in need of medical attention; and

4 WHEREAS, Erling Hjertager was a successful entrepreneur  
5 and owner of a sawmill that employed many in the County of  
6 Siskiyou and provided an incredible amount of lumber to the  
7 World War II effort; and

8 WHEREAS, Crynthia and Erling Hjertager were true  
9 community leaders that headed the Boy Scouts, sponsored local  
10 basketball teams, lead the Masonic society, anonymously  
11 donated to numerous charities, and delivered wood to the elderly  
12 during the winter season; now, therefore, be it

13 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*  
14 *thereof concurring,* That the Legislature recognizes the  
15 contributions of Crynthia and Erling Hjertager and designates the  
16 portion of State Highway Route 3 between Etna and Callahan in  
17 the County of Siskiyou as the Crynthia and Erling Hjertager  
18 Memorial Highway; and be it further

19 *Resolved,* That the Legislature renames the Wildcat Creek  
20 Bridge on State Highway Route 3 in the County of Siskiyou as  
21 the Erling Hjertager Memorial Bridge; and be it further

22 *Resolved,* That the Department of Transportation is requested  
23 to determine the cost of erecting appropriate signs and markers,  
24 consistent with the signing requirements for the state highway  
25 system, showing these special designations, and upon receiving  
26 donations from nonstate sources covering the cost, to erect those  
27 signs and markers; and be it further

28 *Resolved,* That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit  
29 copies of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and  
30 the author for appropriate distribution.
