Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 139—Relative to NASCAR.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 139, as introduced, Emmerson. NASCAR Day.

This measure would express the Legislature's declaration of May 19, 2006 as NASCAR Day for the State of California, encourage fans to make a \$5 donation to the NASCAR Foundation, and encourage fans to wear their NASCAR Day lapel pins to show their support.

1 WHEREAS, California is home to the California Speedway,  
2 host of two 2006 NASCAR Nextel Cup races; and

3 WHEREAS, May 19, 2006 is the third annual NASCAR Day,  
4 a one-day celebration of NASCAR spirit; and

5 WHEREAS, The mission of NASCAR Day is to encourage  
6 individuals and corporations involved in NASCAR to join  
7 together to support the NASCAR Foundation; and

8 WHEREAS, The NASCAR Foundation was formed to support  
9 a wide range of charitable initiatives that reflect the core values  
10 of the entire NASCAR family; and

11 WHEREAS, On NASCAR Day, fans are encouraged to make  
12 a five dollar (\$5) donation to the NASCAR Foundation, and wear  
13 their NASCAR Day lapel pin to show their support; and

1 WHEREAS, NASCAR Day is an opportunity for fans to show  
2 their support for the sport, and help charities related to NASCAR  
3 drivers, teams, and tracks; now, therefore, be it

4 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*  
5 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature declares May 19, 2006  
6 as NASCAR Day for the State of California, encourages fans to  
7 make a five dollar (\$5) donation to the NASCAR Foundation,  
8 and encourages fans to wear their NASCAR Day lapel pin to  
9 show their support; and be it further
