An act to add Section 19316.5 to the Food and Agricultural Code, relating to kitchen grease.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1065, as amended, Matthews. Kitchen grease: transporters.

Existing law requires any person who engages in the transportation of inedible kitchen grease, as defined, to be registered with the Department of Food and Agriculture. Existing law requires licensed renderers to record and keep certain records relating to receipt of inedible kitchen grease. Registered transporters and licensed renderers are required to exhibit those records on demand to any peace officer, among others.

This bill would authorize the department to establish a system for documenting and tracking the transportation of inedible kitchen grease in order to ensure the proper disposal or recycling of that material.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION. 1. Section 19316.5 is added to the ~~Penal~~ *Food and*
- 2 *Agricultural* Code, to read:

1 19316.5. The department is authorized to establish a system  
2 for documenting and tracking the transportation of inedible  
3 kitchen grease in order to ensure the proper disposal or recycling  
4 of that material.
