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An act relating to transportation funding.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2028, as introduced, Huff. Transportation funding.

Existing provisions of the California Constitution establish the Transportation Investment Fund in the State Treasury which provides funds for purposes of public transit and mass transportation, transportation capitol improvement projects, and local street and highway maintenance. These provisions authorize the suspension of the transfer of revenues from the General Fund to the Transportation Investment Fund in a fiscal year if the Governor issues a specified proclamation and the Legislature enacts a specified statute.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to provide an appropriation in the Budget Act of 2007 or in related legislation during the 2007-08 fiscal year to repay fully all funds which would have been transferred to the Transportation Investment Fund in previous fiscal years, but for the enactment of statutes providing for the suspension of those transfers.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to provide an  
2 appropriation in the Budget Act of 2007 or in related legislation  
3 during the 2007-08 fiscal year to repay fully all funds which  
4 would have been transferred from the General Fund to the  
5 Transportation Investment Fund in previous fiscal years, but for  
6 the enactment of statutes providing for the suspension of those  
7 transfers.

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
