An act to add Section 33355 to the Education Code, relating to pupils.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2312, as introduced, Strickland. Pupil transfer policy: interscholastic athletics and activities.

Under existing law, the State Department of Education has certain authority over interscholastic activities including that if the department states that a school district, an association, or consortium of school districts, or the California Interscholastic Federation is not in compliance with state or federal law, the department may require the school district, association, or consortium, or the federation to adjust its policy so that it is in compliance. Under existing law, the department is prohibited from determining the specific policy that a school district, association, or consortium, or the federation must adopt in order to comply with state and federal laws.

This bill would prohibit school districts, associations or consortia of school districts, the California Interscholastic Federation, voluntary associations, or any other entity that governs interscholastic athletics or activities from prohibiting a pupil who transfers to a school from participating in interscholastic athletics or activities at that school.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33355 is added to the Education Code,

3 33355. School districts, associations or consortia of school
4 districts, the California Interscholastic Federation, voluntary
5 associations, or any other entity that governs or regulates
6 interscholastic athletics or activities shall not prohibit a pupil
7 who transfers to a school from participating in interscholastic
8 athletics or activities at that school.
