CHAPTER 46

An act to amend Section 1700.15 of the Labor Code, relating to talent agencies.

[Approved by Governor July 18, 2005. Filed with
Secretary of State July 18, 2005.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 184, Murray. Talent agencies.

Existing law requires talent agencies to deposit with the Labor Commissioner, prior to the issuance or renewal of a license, a surety bond in the amount of \$10,000.

This bill would instead require talent agencies to deposit a surety bond in the amount of \$50,000.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1700.15 of the Labor Code is amended to read:

1700.15. A talent agency shall also deposit with the Labor Commissioner, prior to the issuance or renewal of a license, a surety bond in the penal sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).
