SENATE BILL

~~An act to amend Section 9 of Chapter 731 of the Statutes of 1998, and to amend Section 10 of Chapter 974 of the Statutes of 2002, relating to state property. Section 5071 of the Penal Code, relating to prison inmates.~~

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 185, as amended, Battin. ~~State property: armory: lease: Inmate labor assignments.~~

Existing law prohibits a prison inmate from being assigned to any task that would provide access to personal information of private individuals, as specified, excepting incidental contact in employment programs and public service facilities.

This bill would subject to immediate disciplinary action an inmate who is found present within 25 feet of that personal information.

~~(1) Existing law authorizes the Director of General Services, with the approval of the Military Department and the State Public Works Board, to convey to the Roman Catholic Bishop, Sacramento a corporation sole/St. Francis High School, approximately 6 acres of property known as the 58th Street Armory, with consideration for the exchange to be a replacement facility constructed on other state or federal lands available to the Military Department and cash as~~

necessary to equalize the transaction and reimburse the Department of General Services for its costs, subject to specified conditions.

~~Existing law creates in the State Treasury the Armory Fund money in which are available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for the maintenance of existing armories and for the acquisition or construction of new or replacement armories.~~

~~This bill instead would authorize the director, with the approval of the Military Department and the State Public Works Board, to grant to the corporation an option to purchase or lease with option to purchase the property, with the option to be exercised within 90 days from completion of a replacement facility, subject to specified conditions. It would provide that the net proceeds of any moneys received from the disposition of properties under these provisions that are armories shall be deposited in the Armory Fund and available for appropriation in accordance with existing law.~~

~~(2) Existing law authorizes the Director of General Services, with the concurrence of the Adjutant General, to lease approximately 1.4 acres of property known as the 58th Street Armory to the Archdiocese of Sacramento, for a period not to exceed 7 years, for purposes of constructing a parking lot.~~

~~This bill instead would authorize the director, with the concurrence of the Adjutant General, to lease the property to the archdiocese for a period not to exceed 11 years, and would include maintaining the parking lot within the purposes of the lease.~~

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5071 of the Penal Code is amended to

3 5071. (a) The Secretary of the Department of Corrections
4 and Rehabilitation shall not assign any prison inmate to
5 employment that provides that inmate with access to personal
6 information of private individuals, including, but not limited to:
7 addresses; telephone numbers; health insurance, taxpayer, school,
8 or employee identification numbers; mothers' maiden names;
9 demand deposit account, debit card, credit card, savings, or
10 checking account numbers, PINs, or passwords; social security
11 numbers; places of employment; dates of birth; state or

1 government issued driver's license or identification numbers;
2 alien registration numbers; government passport numbers; unique
3 biometric data, such as fingerprints, facial scan identifiers, voice
4 prints, retina or iris images, or other similar identifiers; unique
5 electronic identification numbers; address or routing codes; and
6 telecommunication identifying information or access devices.

7 (b) Any person who is a prison inmate, and who has access to
8 any personal information, shall disclose that he or she is a prison
9 inmate before taking any personal information from anyone.

10 (c) *No inmate shall be assigned to work within 25 feet of any*
11 *personal information. Any inmate who is found present within*
12 *that distance shall be subject to immediate disciplinary action.*

13 (d) This section shall not apply to inmates in employment
14 programs or public service facilities where incidental contact
15 with personal information may occur.
