An act to amend Section 10609 of, and to add Section 4010.5 to, the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to social services.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 201, as amended, Simitian. Inventory of *state plans*, cooperative agreements, and *contracts* with the federal government.

Existing law establishes the State ~~Departments~~ *Department* of Social Services and ~~Developmental Services~~ and sets forth ~~their~~ *its* powers and duties.

This bill would require the ~~departments~~ *department* to, during *legislative budget hearings*, annually provide the Legislature with an inventory of existing and proposed *state plans submitted to*, cooperative agreements *with*, and contracts with, the federal government.

4 10609. (a) The department may act as the agent or
5 representative of or cooperate with the federal government in any
6 matters within the scope of the functions of the department, for
7 the administration of federal funds granted to this state or for any
8 other purpose in furtherance of those functions.

9 (b) The department may cooperate with the federal
10 government, its agencies or instrumentalities, in establishing,
11 extending, and strengthening services for the protection and care
12 of homeless, dependent, and neglected children, and children in
13 danger of becoming delinquent, and may receive and expend all
14 funds made available for such purposes by the federal
15 government to the department, the state, a county, a district, a
16 municipal corporation, or a political subdivision.

17 (c) Any contract or agreement entered into by the department
18 with the federal government or any agency thereof for the
19 expenditure of any funds in the exercise of any power granted to
20 the department by this section shall be subject to approval by the
21 State Department of Finance.

22 (d) The department shall annually, *during legislative budget*
23 *hearings*, provide the Legislature with an inventory of existing
24 and proposed ~~cooperative agreements and contracts with state~~
25 *plans submitted to, cooperative agreements with, and contracts*
