~~An act to add Section 23058 to the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages. An act relating to state property, and making an appropriation therefor.~~

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 276, as amended, Denham. ~~Alcoholic beverages: reports: electronic filing. State property: Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation: Correctional Training Facility: Soledad.~~

~~The Alcoholic Beverage Control Act is administered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, which among other duties, authorizes the issuance of various alcoholic beverage licenses to qualified applicants.~~

~~This bill would require the department to establish and implement procedures to provide for the electronic transmission of forms and documents that are required to be submitted to the department by licensees and applicants for a license.~~

~~Existing law authorizes the Director of General Services to dispose of state surplus property, subject to specified conditions, including authorization by the Legislature.~~

~~This bill would authorize the director to convey to the City of Soledad, subject to terms, conditions, reservations, and exceptions~~

determined by the director, a specified part of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation Correctional Training Facility at Soledad. The net proceeds of the conveyance would be paid into the Deficit Recovery Bond Retirement Sinking Fund Subaccount, which is continuously appropriated, thereby making an appropriation.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 *SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the*
 2 *Director of General Services may sell, lease, convey, or*
 3 *exchange at current fair market value to the City of Soledad upon*
 4 *those terms and conditions and subject to those reservations and*
 5 *exceptions as the Director of General Services determines are in*
 6 *the best interests of the state, all or any part of the following real*
 7 *property:*

8 *Approximately 33.5 acres of the facility known as the*
 9 *California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation*
 10 *Correctional Training Facility, Soledad, Monterey County*
 11 *Assessor Parcel Numbers 257-041-020 and 257-041-021.*

12 *SEC. 2. Any sale, lease, conveyance, or exchange of the*
 13 *parcels described in this act is exempt from Chapter 3*
 14 *(commencing with Section 21100) to Chapter 6 (commencing*
 15 *with Section 21165), inclusive, of Division 13 of the Public*
 16 *Resources Code.*

17 *SEC. 3. The net proceeds of any moneys received from the*
 18 *disposition of any parcels described in this act shall be paid into*
 19 *the Deficit Recovery Bond Retirement Sinking Fund Subaccount,*
 20 *as created by subdivision (f) of Section 20 of Article XVI of the*
 21 *California Constitution.*

22 *SEC. 4. In implementing this act, the Director of General*
 23 *Services shall except and reserve to the state all mineral*
 24 *deposits, as defined in Section 6407 of the Public Resources*
 25 *Code, together with the right to prospect for, mine, and remove*
 26 *the deposits. The rights to prospect for, mine, and remove the*
 27 *deposits shall be limited to those areas of the property conveyed*
 28 *that the director, after consultation with the State Lands*
 29 *Commission, determines to be reasonably necessary for the*
 30 *removal of the deposits.*
