An act to amend Section 23952 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 322, as introduced, Migden. Alcoholic beverages: liquor license.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Act provides for an application process to obtain a license to sell alcoholic beverages.

This bill would require the application to include a copy of a valid seller's permit issued to the applicant by the State Board of Equalization.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 23952 of the Business and Professions  
2 Code is amended to read:  
3 23952. The application shall also ~~contain a~~ include the  
4 following:  
5 (a) A statement to the effect that the applicant has not been  
6 convicted of a felony and has not violated and will not violate or  
7 cause or permit to be violated any of the provisions of this  
8 division or any rule of the department applicable to the applicant  
9 or pertaining to the manufacture, sale, or distribution of alcoholic  
10 beverages, particularly any of the provisions of Sections 25500 to  
11 25504, inclusive, or Sections 25611 to 25615, inclusive. If the  
12 applicant cannot make this statement the application shall contain

1 a statement of the violation, if any, or reasons which will prevent  
2 the applicant from being able to comply with the requirements  
3 with respect to the statement.

4 *(b) A copy of a valid seller's permit issued to the applicant by*  
5 *the State Board of Equalization.*
