An act to amend Section 5006 of the Food and Agricultural Code, relating to pests.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1418, as introduced, Denham. Pests.

Existing law defines "pest" for purposes of provisions relating to the control and eradication of things that are, or are liable to be, dangerous or detrimental to agriculture.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5006 of the Food and Agricultural Code

3 5006. "Pest" means any of the following things that is, or is
4 liable to be, dangerous or detrimental to the agricultural industry

6 (a) Any infectious, transmissible, or contagious disease of any
7 plant, or any disorder of any plant ~~which~~ *that* manifests
8 symptoms or behavior which the ~~director~~ *secretary*, after
9 investigation and hearing, finds and determines is characteristic
10 of an infectious, transmissible, or contagious disease.
11 (b) Any form of animal life.

- 1 (c) Any form of vegetable life.
