~~An act to amend Sections 17070.40, 17078.52, 17078.54, and 17078.58 of, and to add Part 69.2 (commencing with Section 102000) to Division 14 of Title 3 of, the Education Code, relating to education facilities, by providing the funds necessary therefor through an election for the issuance and sale of bonds of the State of California and for the handling and disposition of those funds. LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 100, as amended, Mullin. Education facilities: Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Bond Act of 2008.

~~(1) Existing~~

Existing law, the California Constitution, prohibits the Legislature from creating a debt or liability that singly or in the aggregate with any previous debts or liabilities exceeds the sum of \$300,000, except by an act that (a) authorizes the debt for a single object or work specified in the act, (b) has been passed by a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote of all the members elected to each house of the Legislature, (c) has been submitted to the people at a statewide general or primary election, and (d) has received a majority of all the votes cast for and against it at that election.

The Leroy F. Greene School Facilities Act of 1998 requires the State Allocation Board to allocate to applicant school districts, prescribed

per-unhoused-pupil state funding for construction and modernization of school facilities, including hardship funding, and supplemental funding for site development and acquisition.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to enact the a Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Bond Act of 2008, to become operative only if approved by the voters at the November 4, 2008, statewide general election, and would to provide for the submission of that act to the voters at that election. The bill would state that is also is the intent of the Legislature that a bond act, if approved by the voters at that election, would provide for the issuance of \$9,087,000,000 of state general obligation bonds to provide aid to school districts, county superintendents of schools, and county boards of education, the California Community Colleges, the University of California, the Hastings College of the Law, and the California State University to construct and modernize education facilities.

~~(3) The bill would specify that certain provisions of the bill shall become operative only if the Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Bond Act of 2008 is approved by the voters at the November 4, 2008, statewide general election.~~

~~(4) The bond provisions described above would be exempted from certain provisions of existing law relating to elections.~~

~~(5) Conforming, technical changes would be made in related provisions of existing law.~~

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. *It is the intent of the Legislature to enact a*
 2 *Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Bond Act of*
 3 *2008, to become operative only if approved by the voters at the*
 4 *November 4, 2008, statewide general election, and to provide for*
 5 *the submission of the board act to the voters at that election. It is*
 6 *also the intent of the Legislature that a bond act, if approved by*
 7 *the voters at that election would provide for the issuance of*
 8 *\$9,087,000,000 of state general obligation bonds to provide aid*
 9 *to school districts, county superintendents of schools, and county*
 10 *boards of education, the California Community Colleges, the*
 11 *University of California, the Hastings College of the Law, and the*
