Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 139—Relative to the Kimberly Marie Hamilton Memorial Interchange.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 139, as introduced, Villines. The Kimberly Marie Hamilton Memorial Interchange.

This measure would designate the State Highway Route 180 interchange at Fowler Avenue in the City of Fresno as the Kimberly Marie Hamilton Memorial Interchange. The measure would also request that the Department of Transportation determine the cost for appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, erect those signs.

- 1 WHEREAS, Kimberly Marie Hamilton was born on August 14,
2 1987, in Fresno, California; and
3 WHEREAS, Kimberly attended Clovis East High School in
4 Fresno, California, and was an avid golfer and hockey fan; and
5 WHEREAS, Kimberly spoke often of becoming a teacher, and
6 was loved and respected by family and friends; and
7 WHEREAS, On May 7, 2004, Kimberly was the victim of a car
8 accident that occurred on Fowler Avenue near Belmont Avenue
9 in the City of Fresno under tragic circumstances involving a
10 construction vehicle; and

1 WHEREAS, Kimberly’s death has affected and touched many
2 people’s lives, and has increased the call for better safety practices
3 in and around roadway construction sites; and

4 WHEREAS, Kimberly continues to be remembered for her sense
5 of humor, laughter, and smile, and is survived by her parents, two
6 brothers, and one sister; and

7 WHEREAS, The Legislature hereby expresses its deepest
8 sympathy to Kimberly’s family, and wishes to designate a highway
9 interchange located near the site of Kimberly’s death as the
10 Kimberly Marie Hamilton Memorial Interchange; now, therefore,
11 be it

12 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
13 *thereof concurring,* That the State Highway Route 180 interchange
14 at Fowler Avenue in the City of Fresno be designated as the
15 Kimberly Marie Hamilton Memorial Interchange; and be it further

16 *Resolved,* That the Department of Transportation is requested
17 to determine the cost of appropriate signs, consistent with the
18 signing requirements for the state highway system, showing that
19 special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate
20 sources sufficient to cover that cost, to erect those signs; and be it
21 further

22 *Resolved,* That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
23 of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the
24 author for appropriate distribution.
