Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 150—Relative to the Joan Bechtel Memorial Highway.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 150, as amended, La Malfa. Joan Bechtel Memorial Highway. This measure would designate the Tudor Bypass segment of State Highway Route 99 in Sutter County, *as specified*, as the Joan Bechtel Memorial Highway. The measure would also request the Department of Transportation to determine the cost for appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, Joan Bechtel was elected to the Sutter County
- 2 Board of Supervisors in November 1992, and subsequently
- 3 represented the citizens of the Fourth Supervisorial District from
- 4 January 1993 to May 2002; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Joan Bechtel served as the Sutter County
- 6 Clerk-Recorder from May 2002 to December 2007; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Joan Bechtel also showed her commitment to the
- 8 community by serving as a member of the Fremont-Rideout Health
- 9 Group's Board of Directors for 25 years; and

1 WHEREAS, Ms. Bechtel further showed her commitment to
2 the community by serving on the Yuba-Sutter Fair Board for eight
3 years; and

4 WHEREAS, During her tenure as a county supervisor, Ms.
5 Bechtel led the effort to widen State Highway Route 99 for the
6 safety of all citizens of Sutter County and all those that travel along
7 State Highway Route 99; and

8 WHEREAS, As a direct result of her efforts, there has been a
9 precipitous drop in accident rates and fatalities on State Highway
10 Route 99; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Bechtel passed away on June 25, 2008, and
12 the Legislature wishes to honor her commitment and dedication
13 to Sutter County and believes that it would be a fitting memorial
14 to Ms. Bechtel to dedicate the portion of State Highway Route 99
15 that she fought so hard to improve as the Joan Bechtel Memorial
16 Highway; now, therefore, be it

17 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
18 *thereof concurring, That the Tudor Bypass segment of State*
19 *Highway Route 99 in Sutter County, from the intersection of State*
20 *Highway Route 99 and State Highway Route 113 south to the*
21 *intersection of State Highway Route 99 and Central Avenue, be*
22 *designated as the Joan Bechtel Memorial Highway; and be it further*

23 *Resolved, That the Department of Transportation is requested*
24 *to determine the cost of appropriate signs, consistent with the*
25 *signing requirements for the state highway system, showing that*
26 *special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate*
27 *sources sufficient to cover that cost, to erect those signs; and be it*
28 *further*

29 *Resolved, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies*
30 *of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the*
31 *author for appropriate distribution.*
