An act to amend Section 17554 of the Government Code, relating to state mandates.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 281, as introduced, Silva. State mandates: Commission on State Mandates.

The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state. Statutory provisions establish the Commission on State Mandates and specify procedures for making that reimbursement, including a provision that, with the agreement of all parties to a test claim, the commission may waive the application of any procedural requirement.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these statutory provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 17554 of the Government Code is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 17554. With the agreement of all parties to ~~the~~ a test claim,
- 4 the commission may waive the application of any procedural
- 5 requirement imposed by this chapter or pursuant to Section 17553.

- 1 The authority granted by this section includes the consolidation
- 2 of claims and the shortening of time periods.
