An act relating to alcoholic beverages.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 323, as introduced, Evans. Alcoholic beverage licensees: wine.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Act authorizes a person issued a winegrower's license to conduct winetastings either on or off the winegrower's premises, subject to specified restrictions, including a prohibition on the sale of wine at specified events sponsored by nonprofits, as provided.

This bill states the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to allow additional specified licensees to donate wine to nonprofits and pour wine at events sponsored by nonprofits.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 legislation to authorize beer and wine wholesale licensees and
- 3 retail package off-sale beer and wine licensees to donate wine to
- 4 nonprofits and pour wine at events sponsored by nonprofits.
