An act relating to workers' compensation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 507, as introduced, De La Torre. Workers' compensation insurance: database.

Existing workers' compensation law requires employers to secure the payment of workers' compensation, including medical treatment, for injuries incurred by their employees that arise out of, or in the course of, employment.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to create a publicly accessible database regarding workers' compensation insurance to enforce state workers' compensation laws.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.
