An act to amend Section 69950 of the Government Code, relating to court transcription fees.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 582, as introduced, Evans. Court transcription fees.

Existing law establishes the fees for obtaining court transcriptions. The fee for a first copy to any court, party, or other person who does not simultaneously purchase the original is \$0.20 for each 100 words, and for each additional copy, purchased at the same time, \$0.15 for each 100 words.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 69950 of the Government Code is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 69950. (a) The fee for transcription for original ribbon or
- 4 printed copy is eighty-five cents (\$0.85) for each 100 words, and
- 5 for each copy purchased at the same time by the court, party, or
- 6 other person purchasing the original, fifteen cents (\$0.15) for each
- 7 100 words.

1 (b) The fee for a first copy to any court, party, or other person
2 who does not ~~simultaneously~~ purchase *at the same time* the original
3 shall be twenty cents (\$0.20) for each 100 words, and for each
4 additional copy, purchased at the same time, fifteen cents (\$0.15)
5 for each 100 words.
