LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 627, as introduced, Walters. State correctional system.

Existing law authorizes the release of prisoners to parole.

This bill would express the Legislature's intent to enact legislation relating to the early release of prisoners, who, upon release, may be eligible to reside in sober living facilities, rehabilitation houses, or halfway houses.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

- 2 legislation relating to the early release of prisoners, who, upon

- 4 rehabilitation houses, or halfway houses.
