An act relating to health care coverage.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 731, as introduced, Solorio. Health care coverage: public agencies.

Existing law, the Knox-Keene Health Care Service Plan Act of 1974, provides for the licensing and regulation of health care service plans. Existing law provides for the regulation of health insurers by the Department of Insurance.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to require health care coverage providers to disclose to public agency governing boards that they contract with all fees and commissions paid to the agency's insurance broker.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to require health
2 care coverage providers to disclose to public agency governing
3 boards that they contract with, such as school boards, city councils,
4 and special district boards, any and all fees and commissions paid
5 to the agency's insurance broker.
