LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 768, as introduced, Walters. Education finance: categorical education programs: consolidation.

Existing law establishes various categorical education programs under which funding is provided for specific educational purposes.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to consolidate certain funds currently allocated to school districts through various categorical education programs.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 legislation to consolidate certain funds currently allocated to school
- 3 districts through various categorical education programs.
