LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 848, as introduced, Solorio. Local government: home ownership assistance.

Existing law provides programs to assist various income levels in obtaining housing and home ownership.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would improve local governments' ability to assist moderate income families with home ownership opportunities.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 legislation that would improve local governments' ability to assist
- 3 moderate income families with home ownership opportunities
- 4 using redevelopment funds and other housing programs.
